- Work in conjunction with primaries team to develop relationships with financial sponsors in order to help source investment opportunities
- Review transaction documentation; prepare closing certificates, valuation analyses and the periodic reports (commentary and numerical data) used to communicate with fund investors.
- Support fundraising efforts including preparation of marketing documents and communication with investors
- Complete one-off projects as they may arise from time-to-time.
