Assist in on-going valuations, reporting to investors, on-going capital raising and on-going asset management of the current portfolio.

Tasks and Responsibilities:

Your responsibilities will include:

- Lead transaction work stream including due diligence and negotiation with developers and partners
- Participate and support the team in deals origination

- Management of Financial Models – an in depth knowledge of financial modelling in order to calculate project returns
- Responsible for drafting of Investment papers to provide the investment committee with information related to the financial performance of projects and investment rationale
- Represent the team at meetings, conferences, and internal discussions
- Be able to lead high-level negotiations with relevant counter-parties on transactions both pre and post-acquisition
- Sensitivity Analysis to appraise projects and provide information on the performance of project under different scenarios
- Presentation of financial models to investors to communicate the returns of the projects we are looking to invest in
- Compile quarterly reports for debt financiers and investors including the calculation of covenant ratios
- Assist in the preparation of annual budgets for project entities
- Respond to investor requests in a timely manner and provide appropriate documentation
